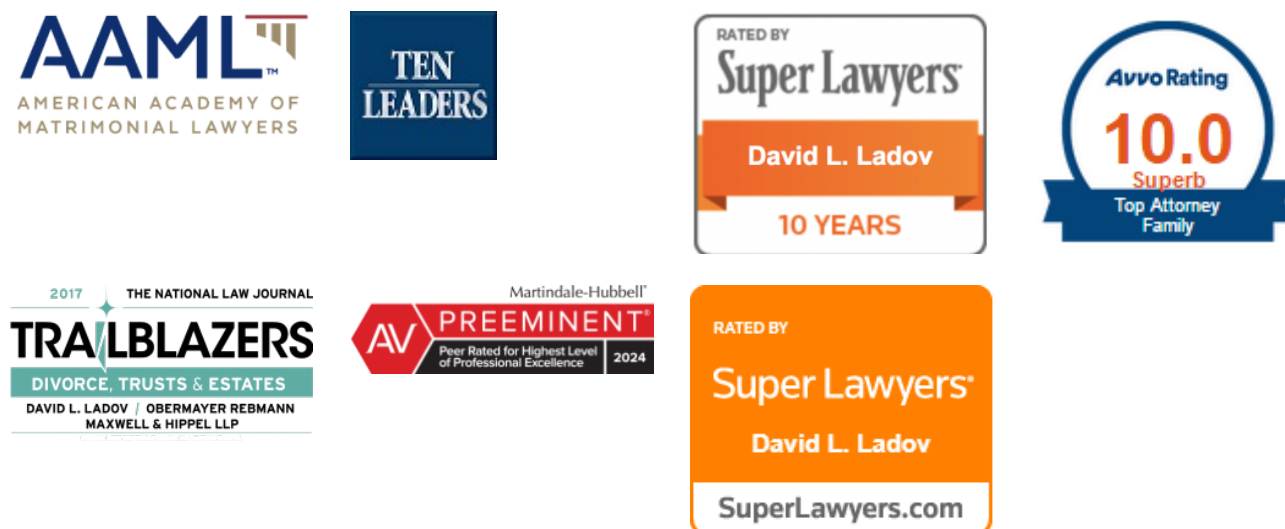
ACTIVITIES & HONORS
